Hello I'm Paul Roberts, and I offer guitar lessons, workshops, and entertainment. I specialize in teaching kids and beginners of all ages. Lessons are tailored to make learning positive and fun, while gently covering essential musical concepts. Students are encouraged to choose their own pieces, and are empowered to set and meet their own goals in a supportive and engaging learning environment. My unique student-directed approach to instruction centers around each individual's learning styles.

My lessons are comprised of:

- Tuning instruction and ear training
